1. Posting Foundation Land for Public Use:

Mike North said that there has been inquiries at the Town Board meetings to post the public use areas on Long Lake that have been established by the Long Lake Foundation. Since these areas are tax exempt, public use is allowed and they should be posted. Concern was expressed by members of the board as to what usage might occur, what was allowed under the Foundation conditions of use and who would be policing the areas for proper usage. The request for posting would be forwarded by the President to the Foundation.

2. Town Ordinance Posting at Boat Landing for Public Swim areas:

Mike North said that the Town has an ordinance for public swim areas and posts this at the public boat landing. Since the Chippewa Bay had a designated swim area for the camp, is it still to be part of the ordinance and posting since the camp has been sold? No, the camp has been sold and the swim area of the camp should no longer be part of the swim ordinance.

3. DNR Designation of Sensitive Areas:

The DNR has completed a study identifying sensitive areas of shoreline on Long Lake. This will be presented at a public meeting next week. Several questions were raised by board members on what this study means to Lake Property owners. What is expected from owners with property in designated sensitive areas? Is any action required by the Lake District or Town Board to implement DNR recommendations? What impact will the designation of these areas have when an owner within an identified area wishes to improve their property? Why was the study done? Pat and Guy will be at the DNR presentation as Lake District representatives.

4. Secluded Land Co. discussion:

Wayne reported that approximately 400 acres which includes about 550' frontage has been purchased by Dr. Kristo. This is about 2/3s of the original camp land that was held by SLC. Al McCoy has completed a layout for lots on the remaining land and will present a copy of the lot layouts and new covenants that go with each lot to Guy at the DNR meeting next week.

5. WAL convention:

Convention is March 7 – 9 at the Green Bay Holiday Inn. Wayne, Guy and Pat will be in attendance.
