

# Help Improve and Protect Lower Long Lake



## Receive a Free Shoreland Evaluation

*Provided by the Lower Long Lake Protection & Rehabilitation District (LLLPRD)*

### **The Shoreland Evaluation Includes:**

- A visit to your property from the shoreland consultant
- A report of your property's current condition
- Specific recommendations to resolve erosion, stormwater runoff, or shoreland vegetation issues
- A plan drawing to show the recommended changes
- A list of native plants (if recommended) that would fit your growing conditions
- An estimated cost of recommended changes

Participants are under no legal obligation to complete the recommendations of their plan, but are strongly encouraged to do so for the good of the lake.



Learn what you can do on your Long Lake property to help improve and protect water quality, fish and wildlife habitat, and help stop shoreline erosion.

If you participate in a property evaluation, you are also eligible for the following Shoreland Incentives.

### 1. Native Plant Group Order

- The participants pay for their own plants, but ultimately receive a discount due to the bulk order. Delivery to a designated area near Lower Long Lake is also arranged. Participants pick up their orders from there.

### 2. Rain Barrels

- The LLLPRD has rain barrels. Participants can either purchase or borrow with a promise to purchase or return them at the end of the season.

### 3. Cost-Sharing

- LLLPRD reimburses landowners (from a grant) for 70% of the total project costs when the participant installs the recommended shoreline buffer, rain garden, or other approved runoff protection practice. The landowner retains the remaining 30% of costs, which can be paid in cash or worked off through labor. The total amount shall not exceed \$3,000 per conservation practice. Other restrictions also apply.
